Dr. Whaley, a 1926 graduate of the University of Toronto was the first specialist pediatrician in the Kitchener Waterloo area practicing there from 1931 through 1970. This fellowship honours his enduring commitment to advanced education and research as related to excellence in clinical practice. The primary objective of the donor is to enhance the health of pregnant mothers and their infants and children and to profile internationally recognized research in this field being carried out in South Western Ontario.

The position is available immediately. The research will explore **the role of in utero oxidative stress upon fetal cardiac development and postnatal dietary manipulations upon later life disease**. Cell based and animal system models will be utilized. We are seeking a highly motivated postdoctoral fellow, MD and/or PhD with previous track record of research in the maternal and newborn health area. This is a one-year fulltime contract position with a potential for renewal for a second year.
