



**Tenure-Track Position

Applications are invited for a tenure-track Assistant Professor position in the Academic Programming Stream in the Department of Physiology at the University of Saskatchewan to begin **July 1, 2016**. The selected candidate will have a PhD degree in Physiology or a related science at the time of appointment. The Department of Physiology offers undergraduate B.Sc. programs and graduate programs leading to M.Sc. and Ph.D. degrees. The selected applicant will teach undergraduate and graduate courses in a variety of areas of physiology as well as teaching physiology to students in Medicine, Dentistry, Nursing, and Pharmacy and Nutrition. The selected candidate will also design and implement senior undergraduate and graduate level laboratory courses for the measurements of physiological variables in animals and humans. Significant teaching experience, demonstrated skills in physiological experimentation, and an ability to work within a team are required. Development of an independent research program is not a requirement of an Academic Programming position.

Current salary bands for this post are as follows: Assistant Professor – \$93,293 - \$112,109; Associate Professor – \$112,109 – \$130,925. This position comes with a comprehensive benefits package that includes pension plan, life insurance (compulsory and voluntary), academic long term disability, sick leave, travel insurance, death benefit, dental plan, extended health and vision care plan, employee assistance program and flexible health and wellness spending program.
